Now that winter is over and the docks are starting to go in at all the local marinas I would like to wish everyone good luck and safe travels on the water. The new docks for the Harbor Beach city marina have been delivered and are currently being installed. There will be lots of upgrades going on at the marina this summer and next so patience may be necessary with the crews doing the work.

One project our club is taking on this year is updating the fish cleaning station at the Harbor Beach city marina. 
